



## BELIEVE CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

The information you share with your Believe support worker is all confidential.

Your support worker makes notes in your file with regards to the type of support they will have provided you, e.g " supported at GP appointment", conversations are kept confidential.

HOWEVER, there is no such thing as complete confidentiality.

Your support worker may need to break confidentiality if they feel that you are a danger to yourself or to others, or if someone is harming you.

Your support worker would never break confidentiality lightly, and they will always seek your permission first before they passed your information on to a third party.

Please also note that your support worker is duty bound to share information that is relevant to your case with other statutory agencies. They will only share the minimum amount of information that they can, and to the minimum number of people in order to keep everyone safe.

All of your personal data will be stored in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations Act ( GDPR) (2018) which is covered in a separate document.
